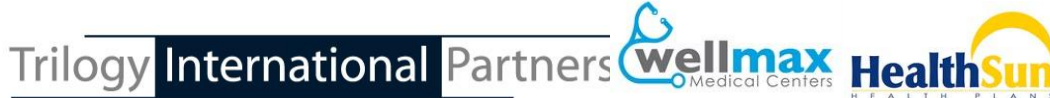

The Jack Brewer Foundation Teams Up with the Clinton Bush Haiti Fund, NFLPA and others for Haiti Relief Effort

On Thursday January 21, 2010, The Jack Brewer Foundation (JBF Worldwide) announced that it will team up with the Clinton Bush Haiti Fund, Trilogi International Partners/Voila, WellMax/Health Sun and Player Associations for the NFL, NBA, NHL and MLB for a large-scale Haiti Relief Effort. This incredible partnership of organizations has created the “**One Team 4 Haiti**” campaign to raise relief money to provide three stages of aid in Haiti: 1.) Immediate needs for food, water and medical attention; 2.) Mid-term needs for food, water, medicine and shelter; 3.) Long-term rebuilding and recovery. A national Public Service Announcement for the Clinton Bush Haiti Fund featuring several professional athletes will air during the playoffs, Pro Bowl, Super Bowl and NBA All-Star Weekend to urge fans to donate. Accumulated funds will also be allocated to Voilà Earthquake Relief Fund, a *One Team 4 Haiti* partner, to provide free cell phones and service to all aid organizations on the ground in Haiti’s network was the first network to restore service in Haiti within the first 48 hours after the earthquake.

Hosted by Trilogi International Partners/Voilà, a service trip to Haiti with countless NFL athletes will highlight the NFL’s commitment to helping Haiti recover from the recent earthquake devastation. Additionally, JBF Worldwide and its partners will continue to bring awareness about the ongoing need to rebuild and support this impoverished country. In order to help facilitate this trip, WellMax/Health Sun, a Medicare HMO operative in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties, is partnering with their largest provider, WellMax Medical Centers, to provide medical supplies, physicians and financial support towards this widespread relief program.

JBF Worldwide tips off 2010 after an extraordinarily successful past year including ringing the closing bell at the New York Stock Exchange on February 27, 2009 and Founder Jack Brewer being honored with a Congressional Certificate of Appreciation by US Congressman Charles B.
