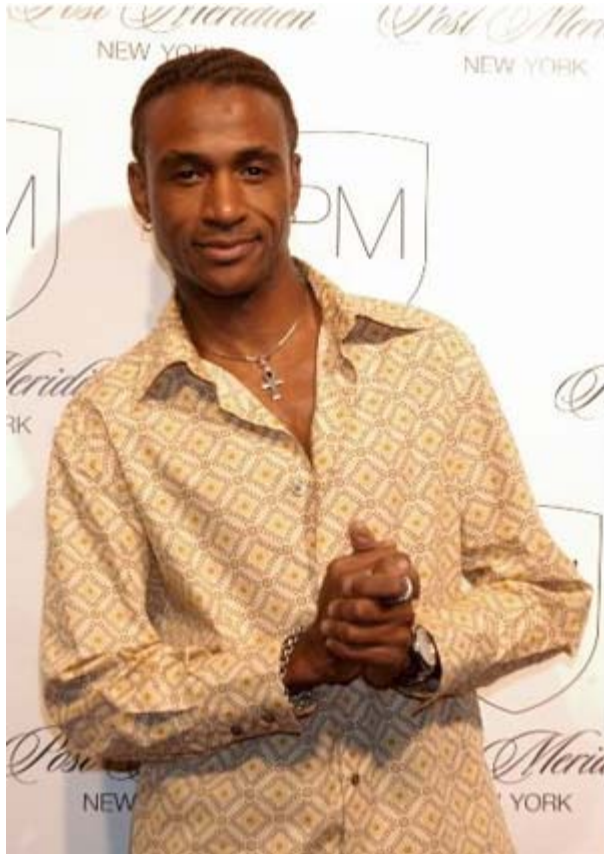


Tommy Davidson Hosts Entertainers Lend a Hand

Celebrity Benefit for Shane's Inspiration set June 10th

Hollenstein, a California native, became a quadriplegic after an accident when he was 25. With no desire to be seen as a victim, Hollenstein is dedicated to living life to the fullest and using his disability in a way that it has not been used before.
